# **Angel Wing Earrings**





#### FINISHED DIMENSIONS

Width: 3 cm (1.1 in) / 4 cm (1.6 in) Length: 5.5 cm (2.2 in) / 6 cm (2.4 in)

#### **MATERIALS**

Hook Size: 2.1 mm / 3.5 mm

Yarn Weight: Light Fingering / Aran

Darning Needle
Optional: Beads

#### YARDAGE

Regular: 3.25 m Large: 4.30 m

#### STITCHES USED

## **CROCHET TERMINOLOGY: CANADA/US**

ch: chain slip knot

sl st: slip stitch

st: stitch

sc: single crochet

hdc: half-double crochet

dc: double crochet
BLO: back loop only

#### **NOTES**

- This pattern comes in two sizes: regular and large. The variation in size is based on changes to yarn weight and not the pattern itself. The larger earring makes it easier to add decorative beads
- If you wish to add beading, you will need to string the beads onto the yarn before starting to crochet



### RIGHT WING

If you want to add beads, string 4 of them onto your yarn before starting.

**ROW 1:** slip knot, chain 13 and turn, sk 3, 1sc into next 10 chains – 10 sc

After the first row, the rest of the piece is worked in BLO.

**ROW 2:** ch 1, turn, 1sc 9 times – 9 sc

Going back along the other side of the same loops in Row 1 that Row 2 was worked into:

ROW 3: ch 3, turn, 1sc, 1dc, 1dc, 1hdc, 1hdc, 1sc 3 times, 2dc - 10 st

Add beads in Row 4 by pulling them down to the piece after stitches 2, 4, 6 and 8.

ROW 4: ch 1, turn, work into Row 3, 1sc 8 times – 8 sc

ROW 5: ch 3, turn, work into the other side of Row 3, 1sc, 1dc, 1dc, 1hdc, 1sc, 1sc, 2dc – 9 st

ROW 6: ch 1, turn, work into Row 5, 1sc 7 times, dec – 7 sc

**ROW 7:** ch 3, turn, work into Row 5, 1sc, 1dc, 1dc, 1hdc, 1sc, 2dc – 8 st

ROW 8: ch 1, turn, work into Row 7, 1sc 6 times – 6 sc

**ROW 9:** ch 3, turn, work into Row 7, 1sc, 1dc, 1dc, 1hdc, 2dc – 7 st

Cut yarn leaving a 10 cm (4 in) tail, thread yarn through the sides of rows 1, 2, 4, 6, 8 and 9. Pull tight and tie.

#### LEET WING

Like the Right Wing, if you want to add beads, string 4 of them onto your yarn before starting.

ROW 1: slip knot, chain 13 and turn, sk 3, 1sc into next 10 chains – 10 sc

After the first row, the rest of the piece is worked in BLO.

**ROW 2:** ch 2, turn, 2dc, 1sc 3 times, 1hdc, 1hdc, 1dc, 1dc – 10 st

ROW 3: ch 3, turn, work into Row 1, 1sc 9 times – 9 sc

**ROW 4:** ch 2, turn, work into Row 3, 2dc, 1sc, 1sc, 1hdc, 1hdc, 1dc, 1dc – 9 st

Add beads in Row 5 by pulling them down to the piece **before** stitches 1, 3, 5 and 7.

**ROW 5:** ch 3, turn, work into the other side of Row 3, 1sc 8 times – 8 sc

**ROW 6:** ch 2, turn, work into Row 5, 2dc, 1sc, 1hdc, 1hdc, 1dc, 1dc – 8 st

ROW 7: ch 3, turn, work into Row 5, 1sc 7 times

ROW 8: ch 2, turn, work into Row 7, 2dc, 1hdc, 1hdc, 1dc, 1dc – 7 st

**ROW 9:** ch 3, turn, work into Row 7, 1sc 6 times – 6 sc

Cut yarn leaving a 10 cm (4 in) tail, thread yarn through the sides of rows 1, 3, 5, 7 and 9. Pull tight and tie.

Once finished and all the ends are sewed in, you can attach the wings onto the earrings.
